KALAELOA

Hunt is revitalizing 540 acres of the former Naval Air Station Barbers Point, the largest redevelopment project in the State of Hawai'i. Extensive infrastructure design and master-planning are currently underway for the community of Kalaeloa, envisioned as a mixed-use community and job center which will provide living options and employment for thousands of Oʻahu residents. To date, Hunt has renovated over 400,000 square feet of former military buildings and leased them to industrial and commercial tenants.



'ĀHUIMANU

'Āhuimanu on the island of Kaua'i is a 42,000 square foot mixed-use development geared to service both the local residents and visitors, and enhance an area recognized as one of the top destinations on the island. The existing plantation-style architecture of Kilauea exudes a historic small town appeal that has been meticulously incorporated into the development's unique green-building and sustainable design features.

DANIEL KAHIKINA AKAKA DEPT. OF VETERANS AFFAIRS COMMUNITY-BASED OUTPATIENT CLINIC

A \$120 million, 88,675 SF multi-specialty outpatient client developed by Hunt in partnership with VA Pacific Islands. The state of the art facility will provide specialized healthcare for more than 87,000 Hawai'i veterans, significantly expanding the services available and increasing access to the VA's advanced technology and providers. The project realizes the vision and mission of the late U.S. Senator Daniel Akaka, who worked tirelessly to ensure that veterans and service members receive the support they need, where they need it.



WĀKEA GARDEN APARTMENTS

Wākea Garden Apartments is the first residential project in Hunt's master plan to redevelop and revitalize approximately 540 acres in Kalaeloa. Once providing housing for military personnel, Wākea Garden Apartments, an adaptive reuse project, offers convenient living options for residents who qualify for affordable housing in west Oʻahu.

WALTER DODS JR. RISE CENTER

In a public-private partnership with the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa and the UH Foundation, Hunt designed, built and financed the \$75 million, six story project at the site of the former Atherton YMCA. Called the Walter Dods Jr. RISE Center (Residences for Innovative Student Entrepreneurs), the 114,000 sf structure integrates academic and collaborative spaces with student housing. Students from multiple disciplines have the opportunity to engage in entrepreneurial education in a one-stop shop for UH programs supporting research, innovation and entrepreneurship.



HĀLAWA VIEW APARTMENTS II

Pacific Development Group, Hunt Capital Partners and Hunt Development Group Hawai'i are partners on the second phase of Hālawa View Apartments, \$170 million, 302 unit affordable high-rise in 'Aiea. The project aligns with the city's Hālawa Area Transit-Oriented Development Plan and is designed by AHL architects, with Nordic PCL as general contractor.
